

OVERVIEW

Universiti Malaya's Bachelor of Laws (Honours) degree is the country's pre-eminent law degree. Alumni have gone on to become the Prime Minister, Chief Justice, Attorney General, senior judges, partners in law firms, general counsels, directors and managers of public listed companies, senior bankers, diplomats, internationally renowned academics, officials of civic societies and others.

The LLB (Hons) prepares you for a career in the law and related fields by giving you a strong working knowledge of a broad range of legal subjects. Conventionally completed over 4 academic years, you will have the opportunity to participate in overseas student exchanges, undertake placement or internships and develop your mooting and writing skills as a lawyer. You may opt to undertake the first two years of the programme in Kuching and complete the remaining two years in Kuala Lumpur, or pursue the full four-year programme entirely in Kuala Lumpur.

Upon completion of the programme, you will be conferred the Bachelor of Laws (Honours) degree. The degree entitles its holder to be admitted as an Advocate and Solicitor of the High Court of Malaya/Sabah/Sarawak after going through a period of pupillage. The programme curriculum comprises both the academic as well as the professional components of legal training.



WHY UMLAW?

- 2. Direct entry to pupillage Unlike many law degrees, the UM LLB (Hons) enables you directly to commence pupillage upon successful completion of the degree. There is no need to sit any further examinations, such as the Certificate of Legal Practice.

International connections Students can participate in international student exchange programmes and represent Malaysia in international competitions, such as moot competitions, debates, mediation and negotiation competitions and more. High achieving students also have a chance to offer a 3+1+1 scheme whereby they can seek a place at a top-ranked law school abroad (for example, Kings College London) to study for a Master degree whilst registered as a LLB student at UMLAW. They will return to UMLAW in the final year to finish their LLB degree.
- 4. Our practical focus Our LLB focuses on practical skills and knowledge. You will be required to undertake legal work related placement or internship during the third year of your studies. There is also an emphasis on mooting skills, advocacy, legal drafting, managing a law practice and alternative dispute resolution skills in the curriculum. You have an opportunity to be involved in supervised legal work through our highly recognised legal aid clinic.
- 5. World Class Faculty UMLAW academics are of the very highest calibre. We publish in internationally rated journals, serve as government consultants, lead on law reform activities, provide training for professionals, present papers at international and national forums and have won large scale research projects.
- 6. Superb learning resources UMLAW holds the country's most impressive law collection.
